HG1-333 Nethertown Pig Farm and HG2-144 Meadow on Old Lane are two sites that are within a short distance of my home and their development would greatly impact on my life and the residents of our green and pleasant little area. Old Lane is a very narrow country lane and not suitable for the amount of traffic that would be generated by this sort of building plus the junction with the A58 Whitehall Road is totally inadequate for high density traffic and dangerous.

Please protect green belt land and this quiet corner of Drighlington.
