I am writing to object to planning proposal for site HG2-12 (4254) for predominantly 2 reasons:-

Knott Lane is barely suitable for additional development. A few weeks ago, a lorry severely damaged the crematorium exit, no doubt leading to unfortunate and expensive repairs paid for by the council. The knock-on effect to traffic exiting the crematorium and trying to access Knott Lane was significant just for those 2 days. . A regular 45 second journey from Knott Lane to Woodlands Drive became 27 minutes. The traffic coming the other way was essentially gridlocked. and mourners were having to park on the A65 itself which was extremely dangerous to themselves and the motorists using that road. Clearly, the turning area in Knott Lane is not suitable for HGV and that has been acknowledged with the new sign erected to that effect.

Greenbelt site. The site is adjacent to the Cragg Wood conservation area and I understand all the trees are covered by TPO. Erosion and damage to this area is unacceptable for the environment.
