To whom it may concern,

I am emailing to object to Leeds City Council's plans to build on greenbelt land for future developments.

I am most concerned about sites HG2-12 around Woodlands drive, HG3-2, HG3-3, HG3-4 off A65, HG2-41 south of A65 and HG2-43 at Horsforth college as these are greenbelt areas that are currently well used and the development of these sites will have a huge detrimental impact on the surrounding areas and infrastructure which simply are not able to facilitate higher usage.

The proposal to use these green belt sites in the local plan is not consistent with the national policy and using greenbelt areas before brownbelt is simply not justified. The proposal to use this strategic green infrastructure goes against the Leeds Core Strategy.

As a family we use many of these area regularly for dog walking and family walk providing us with a space to spend quality family time out in the fresh air and keeping fit. They also are used as a safe place off the roads that my children meet their friends to play. The loss of these areas would be hugely detrimental to myself and others in the local community and have an adverse impact on the quality of life for myself and others in the area.
