For the attention of the planning department.

I, Susan Mercer of 20A Outwood Lane, Horsforth, would like to register my objections to any building on green belt land in general, and in particular I wish to object to the proposed development off the land known as the strawberry fields off the A65 and Ring Road. I understand the need for more housing and am aware that there are still many undeveloped brown field sites in Leeds that which could be used for housing development. The recent building on the old Clariant factory site was in my view, appropriate as it did not encroach on the green belt.

Horsforth is already very congested, and traffic flow on the A65 is at times very slow. To introduce more housing in this area is likely to put great strain on the infrastructure of Horsforth in terms of schools, traffic and medical facilities. I would urge the planning department to refuse planning permission to these green belt sites.
