It has recently been brought to my attention that Church Lane Paddock has been allocated for housing in the site allocation plan.

As a resident of the local area (Jonathan Estate - Home owner - 2 Sunset Rise LS6 4LN) I would like to raise my concern with the above allocation.

The Green Lane/Stonegate Rd junction is an absolute nightmare even at the best of times, as a primary access point to and from the Church Lane site, any further congestion as a result of housing development would be a at a huge loss to existing residents, throughout the Sunsets, Holmewoods and Parksides.

The shopping areas (Aldi centre, Waitrose and the Asda shopping area) are very popular and have problems with access and parking as it is, without any additional residents.

I would also like to stress the potential havoc that development on this site would cause, it has been bad enough over the past year with the laborious road and pathway resurfacing - which is desperately needed and welcome, but has been less than efficient. I dread to think what an inconvenience and burden housing development would be for the local people, with endless road closures, temporary traffic lights, worksite congestion and noise pollution,

I do believe that it is areas like that paddock which give Meanwood it's identity and charm, making it a pleasant place to live and walk around. The last thing we residents need, is a poorly designed and built, out of character blot on the landscape - as many new builds are - causing disruption during the years of construction and after.
