Dear Sir/Madam,

I live at 9 Hall Rise, Bramhope, LS16 9JG

Regarding sites HG2 - 15 (3400), HG2 - 16(1002) and HG2 - 17 (1080 & 3367A).

I disagree with the above sites being allocated for housing for the reasons outlined below.

Bramhope village would be transformed into a small town in terms of population and amount of housing but with inadequate amenities and facilities to support it. In particular I do not believe that the needs of all children will be met by the local school and the proposals do not safeguard their future and education. I don't think it is appropriate for children of primary school age to have to travel out of area to be educated and there will be a knock on impact on capacity in neighbouring schools. I also have major concerns regarding the impact on access to healthcare with hundreds more people needing to access GP services which would simply not be able to cope.

All 3 sites are adjacent to the Bramhope Conservation Area.

The impact on local traffic congestion would be huge. The A660 is already congestion at peak times and there is little scope to improve the route. With no employment opportunities in Bramhope, the number of people having to commute would increase significantly and since public transport is already inadequate, peak commuter time congestion would be intolerable.

Proposed sites are prime green belt land and its use is unjustified and unacceptable.

The plans are not sound and not consistent with National Planning Policy Framework Because lack of infrastructure and use of green belt land.

I do not support the proposals and wish for my opinion to be registered.
