Dear Sir / Madam,

As part of the Leeds Site Allocation Plan public consultation process, I formally object to the proposed development of the following sites: HG2-12, HG2-41, HG2-42 & HG2-43.

The proposed development sites are NOT consistent with the national policy, specifically with regard to Green Belt. Our Green Belt and greenfields must remain protected. I have 3 young children and the Green Belt is part of our natural environment. The roads in the proposed area more congested than ever and development here will further increase congestion on the local highways.

Both the local development and infrastructure requirements must be taken into account. Development of these sites on greenfields will lead to nearby villages being engulfed within the 'Main Urban Area' and they will no longer be separate 'Major Settlements' of their own. Reference, Adopted Core Strategy (Map 3, Settlement Hierarchy).

I travel to work on the A65 to Bradford via the Horsforth roundabout, despite the recent "so called" road improvements, the congestion on the roundabout has become even worse - at 7.15 am there are already tailbacks. This will be even worse with additional housing to the point where efficiency of the roads (effecting both commercial as well as personal traffic) will be severely compromised. I am extremely concerned that local services such as schools and surgeries are already overstretched.

Please keep me informed of the public examinations, submission of the plans and potential outcome of the review as I would like to retain my right to attend and speak.
