I write to express my deep concerns and dismay at the proposal to remove the land off Weetwood Avenue from the Greenspace allocation.

I have lived adjacent to this site for thirty years and enjoy everything that it has to offer.

This site is a haven for wildlife. The wild plants attract butterflies, the brambles are popular nesting spots for birds, there are many varieties of small mammals, red kites are frequent visitors and in the evenings we see many bats and owls.

This site is a beautiful part of the Weetwood Conservation Area attracting many visitors / walkers, and to remove the Green Belt status for further housing would be detrimental to the character of the area.

The council's own analysis has confirmed that there is no shortage of housing land supply in this part of the city, therefore there is no sound reason to destroy this site by removing the Green Belt status.
