I would like to object to the proposed plans to build on the above sites. As a resident in Rawdon this is a matter that is close to my heart and would be very saddened to see our surrounding area destroyed forever. We bought our house in Rawdon 4 years ago purely due to the location and its stunning landscape surroundings and to escape the typical built up areas always found in Leeds.

My main reasons for my objection are as follows;

- It would create a further rise in already current traffic problems in the area. The A65 is already out of control with morning queuing running back for miles.
