I am writing in connection with the further housing proposed for this area.

I do not dispute for one moment that there is chronic shortage of affordable housing in this country.

I have lived in Guiseley for over 40 years and have seen it grow to where the residents now have major stores on the doorstep. More and

more people are, however, now coming to shop in Guiseley resulting in the place becoming a parking lot over the weekends !

I live on the Silverdale estate and apart from the unadopted Coach Road the only exit from the estate is along Silverdale Drive

to join Park Road. Residents of Silverdale Drive, near the Park Road exit, park their cars on the roadside and this can cause problems

particularly in wintry weather.

Turning right on to Park Road used to be a problem caused by cars speeding down in the direction of Morrisons.

This is no longer the case as the traffic is now nose to tail on Park Road and at certain times of the day the line of traffic

can stretch from Bradford Road, at the top, to the A65 at the bottom. Residents leaving the estate are more than ever now reliant

on drivers on Park Road allowing you to turn right to join the queue !

The proposed further developments on Silverdale and Coach Road make no sense whatsoever as they would only add to the major problem

in Guiseley - TRAFFIC CONGESTION
