I would like to object to the proposed development of the following sites-

HG2-4(Hollins Hill)

HG2-5 (Coach Road)

HG2-6 (Silverdale Coach Road allotments)

HG3-1 (Ings Lane)

I am led to understand that the proposed development sites are not in line with national policy, especially in regard to Green Belts.

It is imperative that we protect our Green Belts for future generations.

Having lived in the same house in Guiseley for the past 50 odd years, I have watched my area slowly being surrounded by new properties, some of this on land previously occupied by industrial buildings which is the ideal way.

I can only see chaos on the roads surrounding Ings Lane which along with Netherfield Road is awkward to negotiate even now.

As to the Hollins hill site even if a roundabout or traffic lights are put on the junction of Park Road with the A6038 to Shipley that road is busy enough now without the extra traffic new buildings would bring.

Traffic through Guiseley has always been a problem, especially on the A65. But since latest building sites have been developed, its a shambles.

Development and infrastructure requirements must be considered side by side.

Please also consider carefully the letter sent to you from the Historic England dated 21.10.2015.
