Hi

I live on Westfield Avenue LS197NT.
My journeys have become longer over the past few years as the A65 that I use to exit Westfield Estate to travel either towards Guiseley or Rawdon is generally gridlocked all the time now.

It takes me longer to get to work in Harrogate as not only do I find it increasingly harder to pull out onto the A65 but then no matter which route I take onto the A658 I then have to queue to pull onto this road too.

Particularly around the airport during rush hour I find that traffic is at a standstill or slowly crawling all the way from Murgatroyds down pool bank to the Shell garage.

On a weekend or a weeknight evening if I want to nip to the Nuffield Health gym at Guiseley i find it so frustrating that it can take nearly 30 mins to get there which is bearily a 2 mile journey. I have health issues so cannot walk this far each way otherwise I could walk there faster!

As well as the roads struggling to cope I worry about public services in my area. I can no longer park outside Yeadon tarn medical practice when I need to see a doctor as the car park is always full, and the wait for an appointment keeps getting longer. I cannot access an NHS dentist and had to travel to Otley for my nearest one.

I particularly worry about more houses being built Gill Lane Yeadon, LS19 (plan ref. HG2-10, SHLLA ref. 1221) As this would make traffic on the A65 even worse.

I feel the Yeadon/Guiseley area is reaching saturation point for number of people for the infrastructure and public services and new houses should be greatly limited.

I know there are several different sites planned in the area so have quoted the one nearest me as I feel this will have greatest impact however feel they should all be looked at as a whole as added together will multiply the effects greatly.
