I wish to object most strongly to the following Housing Allocations:-
HG-12; HG3-2/3/4;HG2-41;HG2-43.

The reasons for my objections are:

- 1 The proposal to include these Green Belt sites in the Local Plan is not consistent with the national policy.
- 2The proposal to use Green Belt before brownfield is not justified.
- 3The proposal to use this Strategic Green Infrastructure goes against the Leeds Core Strategy.
