>> d) no supporting infrastructure for above developments.
>>
>> Firstly, the traffic as it is today, is already adding extra time to our journeys.
>> Traffic on A65 and all the surrounding roads is at present being used to its full capacity.
New houses recently built and occupied have added to this flow, all the way from Rodley, from
Menston, from Apperley Bridge, from Kirkstall, and from Burley.
>>
>> Currently there are new developments going on at Apperley Bridge, and on Ring Road at
Horsforth, the latter developments being HG1-96 and the Clariant, which will further add to the
above nightmare.
>>
>> Has careful consideration been given to the impact of these proposed developments?
>>
>>> Our green belts will be lost forever, along with its wildlife habitats and the country walks.
Lack of infrastructure worries me greatly.
No matter which way one looks at these plans, there is no consistency with the
nPPF policy, nor is there any justification, and not effective either.,
>>> I cannot stress the above points enough.

>>> Perhaps I can offer a guided tour to Leeds City Council members to get an experience on
these roads on a working day.
