Dear Sir,

I wish to object to in the inclusion of site HG2 41 in the Site Allocations Plan as the site is green belt. Removing the site from the green belt is contrary to National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) Section 9, paragraph 80 because including the site for development fails the 5 tests of green belt purpose. The inclusion of the site to achieve housing number target is not an exceptional circumstance as per paragraph 83 of NPPF. Based on this I do not think that the Plan is sound as it is not consistent with national policy.

I also wish to object because of the lack of infrastructure in the area. The roads, the Ring road, the Horsforth Roundabout and the A65 which would carry traffic from site HG2 41 are already at maximum capacity and are not capable of coping with any increase in traffic coming from the site.

There is also the problem the new housing would create to the local community. Where would the children go to school when all the local schools are full at the moment? Where would the residents find their health care when local surgeries are already stretched? Where would the new residents shop when local shops are already really busy?

Horsforth is a popular place to live. I believe new housing on the scale proposed would destroy the very nature of Horsforth and the reason it is an attractive place to live.
