Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to object to the development of the site referenced above. I have lived in Rawdon for 47 years and Aireborough already has 2400 new homes in the past 10 years. Whilst the housing has increased there has been no improvement plans to support these proposals.

My objection is based on the following:

The plan for the site was not prepared positively. It isn't based on a comprehensive greenbelt review, doesn't take our communities views into account or involve us.

We only knew about plans because of the local action group. Had that not formed we would not have known about any proposals.

The proposal, along with the other sites involved, would merge Rawdon with Yeadon, Yeadon with Guiseley creating a huge rural sprawl.

The original government target for this area was 70,000 houses but this has since been reduced to 45,000 yet the council has ignored this.

The impact on schools, doctors, dentists and other services would be immense.

The roads are already over crowded and in grid lock daily – I cannot imagine how the roads or services would cope.

This is a brief summary on a proposal that justifies much more opposition – too much green space is being used unnecessarily.
