It is my understanding this site is NOT consistent with the national policy specifically with regard to Green Belt. The fields and open spaces are of significant value to the residents of Horsforth. Horsforth was once described as the largest village in England surrounded by water — in other words to get out of Horsforth you had to cross water whether river, canal, stream or beck.
