Dear Sir or Madam,

I would like to make 2 objections.....

- Firstly I would like to object to Leeds City Council's plans to develop green field sites at the following locations:

site HG1-58 (1191a).

site HG1 - 31 (4000).

site HG1 -29 (1199b).

there are numerous brown field sites that should be developed first. The green field natural spaces should be protected for future generations and not destroyed for short sighted wins. This process is being rushed through too quickly to reach the ridiculous proposed housing targets. How were these calculated? Whilst I appreciate new houses are needed, these should not be built on greenbelt and LCC is trying to do too much all at once. why?

- secondly, I would like to object to the housing plans generally in the Cookridge area. Unlike other urban areas of Leeds, cookridge is already short on amenities and the infrastructure is not set-up for a large increase in traffic. The road network is convoluted and like a maze of small back roads with difficult 'T' junctions with poor visibility and inadequate traffic management. Increasing traffic significantly will increase accidents and traffic jams. The impact on schools, doctors and road networks will be atrocious.

I also think that these plans have not been advertised enough - with little to no consultation.
