Hello,

I am writing to you to voice my concern about the proposed housing developments in Horsforth and Rawdon.

I am not someone who would normally write such an email but after receiving a leaflet through my door from the Liberal Democrats warning me of the proposed plans I feel this email is a must.

My first concern is that some of these housing developments are to be built within a few hundred meters of my house (on new Road Side) and this is the first I have heard about it , two days before the deadline. I do not feel that this is acceptable.

Site HG2-41 is on green belt land, I am sure I am not alone when I say I feel it should remain so. I am sure that there are plenty of Brownfield sites which could be used elsewhere around Leeds. The land between Horsforth and Rawdon is a beautiful area of town. It would be such a shame to ruin this landscape with a housing development. The New Road side roundabout can not handle the traffic that is already there never mind the additional traffic that would be caused by all these proposed developments. Ques regularly stretch over 1 mile in each direction of the Horsforth roundabout, building additional housing along Rawdon Road would only worsen this, already dire, situation.

A major concern of mine is the demand for GP's and Dentists within Horsforth and Rawdon. The local GP surgeries are already over subscribed and it is difficult to get appointments. With these additional housing developments comes a larger population and I hope you have considered the effect of this on Healthcare within the area of Horsforth and Rawdon.

I hope there will be meeting held for local residents to voice their concerns.
