As part of the Leeds Site Allocation Plan public consultation process, I would like to formally object to the proposed development of the following sites:

HG2-41

HG2-12

HG2-43

It is my understanding that the proposed development sites are NOT consistent with the national policy, specifically with regard to Green Belt. Leeds must continue to protect our Green Belt and Greenfields. The fields and open green spaces, which are being proposed for development, are important to me because I live in the this area, on a daily basis I see the issues with traffic. There are no plans to improve the infrastructure. Schools are full and difficult to get into without the additional head count. I also see the extensive wildlife in the area, these developments will have devastating effects on many animals breeding and natural habitats including foxes and red kites to name a couple.

These sites should continue to be part of Leeds' 'Strategic Green Infrastructure' as identified in the Adopted Core Strategy.

It is my understanding that the proposed development sites are NOT consistent with the national policy, specifically with regard to infrastructure. Leeds has insufficient policies in place to address the issues that these developments will generate. Development and infrastructure requirements must be considered side by side.

Development of these sites on Greenfields will lead to nearby villages being engulfed within the 'Main Urban Area' and they will no longer be separate 'Major Settlements' of their own. Reference, Adopted Core Strategy (Map 3, Settlement Hierarchy).
