I would like voice my objection to the proposed new sites in the above areas.

The roads in the areas are already heavily congested and any further building in the area only make matters worse and throw more pollution into the atmosphere from static / slow moving traffic.

Travelling times to and from work has not been enhanced at all by the recent alterations to Horsforth roundabout. The new left only lane to Rodley from New Road Side being a big handicap for cars coming out of the estate at Calverly Lane wanting to cross straight on towards Rawdon. This left only lane needs to be changed back to a left / straight on marking. This will sooner or later cause an accident.

The roads in the area were simply not built to sustain such volumes of traffic. It is bad enough travelling most months of the year. What would increased traffic be like in winter conditions with icy roads.

On another is Street parking around Newlaithes Road school is extremely dangerous. Cars block access into the surrounding roads and park on street corners which is illegal. Double yellow lines need to be introduced and offending cars ticketed. The roads are not safe for pedestrians.
