I am writing on behalf of Mrs. Sheila Masters at 39 The Rowans, Bramhope, Leeds, LS16, at her request, to lodge her objections to the proposed development of the following sites in Bramhope :

HG2-15 (3400) Green Acres and Equestrian Centre
HG2-16 (1002) Creskeld Lane, Bramhope - land to the rear of no. 45
HG2-17 (1080_3367A) Breary Lane East, Bramhope

Bramhope is a village environment, and development of additional housing in these areas would negatively change the nature of the village substantially.

The area of Bramhope is greenbelt land - to build on this land would be unacceptable from an ecological perspective when there is such a huge amount of brownfield sites around Leeds that would benefit from development.

The A660 is already highly over utilised and busy and additional housing would simply increase the traffic pressure on this area. Additional housing would put further acceptable strain on the infrastructure system. And the answer is not to dig up more greenbelt to build bigger roads!

Further development would endanger this area from a Conservation and Ecological perspective, and would blight the landscape in Bramhope. This is a beautiful and ecologically important part of Leeds, and these planning applications would have severe negative impact in this area.

I am objecting to the further development of housing at each of these sites in the Bramhope area.
