I wish to draw attention to major omissions from this Draft document and to urge that further consideration be given to Alwoodley Ward in North Leeds HMCA Area.

The draft records several small sites in Alwoodley Parish but omits many areas of important green space which is of easy access and well used by the public. They should be identified as Green Space and thus protected. Some already has other layers of protection as Green Belt, SSSI or as areas of Special Landscape Quality but the further protection as Green Space will emphasise their place in the planning hierarchy and give additional protection.

I would ask that the following be included:-

Alwoodley Village Green [land on King Lane]
A Large area surrounding Eccup Reservoir
Land in the vicinity of the Leeds Country Way and the Ebor Way
Adel Woods
All areas near to the public rights of way network
The area adjacent to the King Lane Carriageway and the Buckstone Estate

Please note that I make these suggestions personally and not on behalf of Alwoodley Parish Council or the Leeds Local Access Forum but I will be copying this email to them and they may wish to give support to my suggestions even though they may be communicated to you after tomorrow's closure date. With regard to the Parish Council I would comment that as far as I am aware they have not been provided with the draft for comment and I suggest that it is serious omission that they have not been invited to take part in the consultation..
