I would like to lodge an objection to the proposed development of the following sites :

HG2-15 (3400) Green Acres and Equestrian Centre  
HG2-16 (1002) Creskeld Lane, Bramhope - land to the rear of no. 45  
HG2-17 (1080\_3367A) Breary Lane East, Bramhope

Bramhope is a village environment, and development of additional housing in these areas would negatively change the nature of the village substantially.

The area of Bramhope is greenbelt land and is attractive for that very reason - to build on this land would be unacceptable when there is such a huge amount of brownfield sites around Leeds that would benefit from development.

There have been houses built further down Otley Road towards Adel which are an eyesore - they are packed in like sardines and are right up against the side of the road. Clearly there has been no consideration made to the area when these houses were approved.

The traffic around this area is already completely unacceptable. If trying to get into or around Leeds it easily takes 40 minutes in traffic jams to undertake an otherwise 10 minute journey. Additional housing would put further acceptable strain on the infrastructure system. And the answer is not to dig up more greenbelt to build bigger roads!

Finally - the villagers of Bramhope have chosen to live in this greenbelt area because we enjoy the landscape and positive impact the greenbelt has on our conservation and ecology. Developing this area would endanger this area from a conservation perspective.

**In short - I am objecting to the further development of housing in the Bramhope area.**
