My name is John Beck,

I have lived at 24 Rawdon Road, Horsforth LS18 5EW for 14 years and have 3 teenage children.

A major development of housing has been submitted for planning (HG2-41) Over the road from our house.

The proposal to use Green Belt before Brown Field is not justified and the proposal to use this strategic Green infrastructure goes against Leeds core strategy and is not consistent with the National policy.

We are told the country needs affordable housing. How could such a development be classed as this. The area has average house prices well above the average for Leeds, and any new developments would be aimed at an affluent market, not people struggling to get a toe hold in the housing market.

Horsforth Roundabout to Guiseley is already grid locked at peak times and an influx of a large number of what I would speculate are two car families in the area would render the roads unusable.

The schools are already over subscribed and the disruption caused by building work to increase capacity for services and the home building itself would make life here intolerable for years.

This is not taking in to account the damage to the local environment such as Hunger Hill with it's rare blue bell wood and the wildlife that flourishes in the local fields and woods. All of which my children, wife and I have enjoyed every day whilst living here.

I strongly object to this proposal.
