Subject: PDE01500_Housing development in Rawdon and Horsforth
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Before any decision is made with regard to any more houses being built in the Rawdon/Horsforth area any new road to the Airport should be confirmed and published.

With regard to the building of more houses, the question of school places, medical facilities etc must be thought through and allocated.

The A65 is now over used with congestion most of the time, not only rush hour traffic but weekends and virtually all the time.

Work has just finished at the roundabout at junction of the A65 and the Leeds ring road and the practicality of building 777 houses on the site HG2-41 shows no forward planning and would be completely impractical.

The site HG3-4 is subject to flooding and this must be investigated. Rawdon is a small village and would lose its character which might not bother the planning committees but would be a big set-back to local residents. The development of any Green Belt areas is not consistent with the national policy as well as the Leeds core strategy.

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
