Dear Sir/Madam

I write to object to the proposed use of greenbelt land in the vicinity of the major arteries A65 and A6120 using the limited greenbelt land between Horsforth and Rawdon. The Use of HG2-41, HG2-12 and HG3-2 for housing will result in continuous urban sprawl from Leeds City Centre to Guiseley. This is contrary to national policy relating to greenbelt land and its permanence.

Furthermore, the road infrastructure in this part of Leeds is already saturated at peak times. The proposed addition of 777 homes at HG-41 together with 206 at HG2-43 resulting in an additional 1000-2000 car movements at peak times will clearly result in grid-lock at the Horsforth and Rodley junctions.

The Council must recognise the necessity for joined up thinking. It is ludicrous to increase homes in this locality of Leeds with the road infrastructure that they have put in place. Major Improvements to the latter are essential before overloading it further housing.
