Dear Sir/Madam, I wish to formally object to the following proposals for developing greenfield sites in the Horsforth area of Leeds where I live.

HG2-41(4240) greenfields south of A65 from Horsforth roundabout to Rawdon Crematorium including the area known locally as the Strawberry Fields.

HG42 (1016) Fields at Broadway and Calverley Lane, Horsforth.

In my opinion the proposals to develop these sites are contradicting national green belt policy and as a local resident I am totally opposed to them. I have lived in this area for nigh on 70 years during which time I have spent (and still do) many happy hours in this, the nearest countryside within walking distance from my home. My children and grandchildren nowadays accompany myself and my wife and experience the pleasures that I and many others enjoyed and wish to keep enjoying in this natural environment. These proposed developments will not only ruin the locality as a wildlife haven, both educational and enjoyable to both adults and children alike, but will undoubtedly greatly increase traffic on some of the busiest roads in the area, increasing pollution and having an adverse effect on the health and well-being of the local population.
