I note that Leeds City Council are planning to build on the following sites:

1. HG2 - 12 Fields at Woodlands Drive, Rawdon.
2. HG3 -2 , HG3 -3 , HG - 4 Fields off the A65 Rawdon.
3. HG2 -41 Fields south of A65 , Horsforth Roundabout to the crematorium.
4. HG2 - 43 Fields at Horsforth College Campus.

I have lived in Rawdon for over 33 years and it is a very important area for both me and my family who also live in the same area. I am therefore saddened to read that plans are in place to build on the green belt sites mentioned above and I strongly oppose them.

Firstly, the proposal to include these Green Belt sites in the local plan is NOT consistent with the national policy. The proposal to build on these sites is therefore totally unjustified. The traffic on the A65 corridor especially between Rawdon and Guiseley is bad enough all the extra traffic would make it impossible especially on the daily commute. I am also sure that the proposal to use this strategic green infrastructure goes against the Leeds Core Strategy.

The areas that will be built on are used by many people including ourselves for walks through this very pleasant area so the wellbeing health and exercise that will not be on our doorstep anymore will have a big impact in people's lives who live in the area.

I urge you to please re-consider your decisions as it will have a massive impact on people's lives in this area.
