RE: LEEDS SITE ALLOCATION PLANS - FORMAL OBJECTION

Dear Sir / Madam,

As part of the Leeds Site Allocation Plan public consultation process, I would like to formally object to the proposed development of the following sites: HG2-12, HG2-41, HG2-42 & HG2-43.

I believe that the proposed development sites are NOT consistent with the national policy, specifically with regard to Green Belt. Leeds must continue to protect our Green Belt and greenfields. The fields and open green spaces, which are being proposed for development, are important to me because as a family with 3 young children they are part of our natural environment which is becoming ever more congested with houses and the obvious knock on effect of congesting the local highways.

The local development and infrastructure requirements must be considered side by side. Development of these sites on greenfields will lead to nearby villages being engulfed within the 'Main Urban Area' and they will no longer be separate 'Major Settlements' of their own. Reference, Adopted Core Strategy (Map 3, Settlement Hierarchy).

Despite the recent "so called" road improvements, the congestion on the Horsforth roundabout has become even worse. this will be exacerbated further with additional housing stock to the point where efficiency of the roads (effecting both commercial as well as personal traffic) will be severely compromised. Similarly, local services such as schools and surgeries are already extremely stretched.

Please keep me informed of the public examinations, submission of the plans and potential outcome of the review as I would like to retain my right to attend and speak.
