We wish to lodge our protest against your plans for the above sites. We realise it may be too late for HG1-10 but the points are still relevant.

We do not think the plans have been positively prepared.

Greenbelt land and green space is of paramount importance to this area and to the country as a whole. Once built over, it is gone for ever.

We have lived in LS19 all our lives and do not wish to see the character of the area changed beyond all recognition.

Surely you have to consider the quality of life of existing residents/ratepayers?

If these plans were passed in their current guise, the whole area would be well on the way to becoming one large anonymous urban sprawl.

The local infrastructure is already at bursting point. It could not cope with the extra units you are proposing.

We are unconvinced that you have fully considered brownfield sites in the whole Leeds area.

Also, there remains the question of empty housing stock in Leeds. What are you doing to bring it back into occupation at the required standards?

If you carry out your plans as they stand, you will irretrievably damage what at the moment is still a very pleasant place to live.

Your plans as stated will deliver to you an ill thought out 'quick win', which future generations will forever hold against you.

We ask you to reconsider your plans.
