Dear Sirs,

I have lived in Rawdon 40 years. In this time there has been a considerable increase in the number of people using the Rawdon/Horsforth countryside for leisure: walking, cycling, horse riding and bird watching etc. There has also been a noticeable increase in local wildlife. I often see deer in the fields HG2-12, HG3-2, HG3-3, HG3-4 and HG2-41. I believe it would be a tragedy if these green belt fields were lost to all of us and the wildlife. Once gone, they are gone forever.

This proposal to build in the green belt before using brownfield sites is neither justified nor consistent with the national policy. There is insufficient infrastructure to cope with the change of use in this green belt and the proposal is against the Leeds Core Strategy. It is for these reasons that I object to the proposed building on these green belt sites.
