Dear Sir,

Having studied the site allocation for development in the Horsforth area I wish to register my objection to the proposed plans to build 777 homes at Site HG2-41 referred to as the strawberry picking fields. This would completely block the wildlife corridor on the north side of the Aire Valley taking into account its proximity to the recently developed Clariant site.

This site is in Green Belt as identified within Leeds Core Strategy as Strategic Green Infrastructure and is in breach of national planning law. I also believe the combined use of Sites HG2-41, HG2-12, HG3-2 and HG3-3 would completely merge Horsforth and Rawdon which is inconsistent with the NPPF and Leeds Core Strategy.

As a further observation, despite recent improvements to the Horsforth roundabout and the installation of traffic lights the A65 is still horrendously busy with traffic queued back for much of the day. Any building by this part of the A65 with the additional traffic it would produce would totally gridlock the roads here.
