To whom it may concern,

I am writing to express my displeasure at the potential building of 130 houses along woodlands drive in Rawdon (area code HG2-12).

I feel that such building will definitely detract from the natural beauty of the area, as a large setting of so many houses contrasts greatly with the tranquility of what is at the moment an extremely serene area. Furthermore, as green belt land, there is surely some degree of moral responsibility to properly conserve this land, both in terms of allowing the natural habitats to continue to flourish, but also in conserving the character of the area.

The increase in population along woodlands drive (potentially >200 more people) will also drastically over burden the solitary road that is already very difficult to effectively upkeep. Such a large increase will both heavily increase traffic problems and the road could become extremely expensive to maintain and maybe even ineffective in its design.

Alongside such, have other possibilities been effectively explored? There are brownfield sites across the leeds-bradford area that may be more suitable for such plans, and there may even be further alternatives that have also been overlooked.
