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i would like to object to the proposed application of 376 Houses at Breary Lane East

The area of Bramhope does not have the infrastructure to cope with this increase in population. The school is full with children in the area, pupils need to live within a quarter of a mile of the school to have any chance of a place. The doctor's surgery is very small and the car park has parking for about 10 cars. As the car park is in the school parking area it is very difficult to exit and enter the surgery car park it would be very difficult to cope with a large increase in patients. The A660 is one of the busiest routes into Leeds it is impossible to safely enter this route at peak times due to the volume of traffic. It requires a space of 140 meters to join a road where traffic is travelling at 40 miles an hour safely. We have seen an increase in accidents in the area recently there was a three vehicle accident outside the opticians where a van was on its side after hitting a car and demolishing the wall outside the opticians. The road through the village of Bramhope has also become a rat run for people trying to avoid the traffic lights at Pool Bank and traffic going to and from the Airport. The increase in new homes in Otley and Adel has increased the volume of traffic in the area. Please decline this application.
