Ref HG2-12 and HG3-2 and HG3-3 ---- these would ruin Knott Lane area apart from creating more trouble reaching A65 from the crematorium. Woodland Drive is a conservation area - valuable farm land would be lost as well as wild life. HG3-4, Layton Lane fields, which includes Ghyll Beck, has a wild life habitat + protected trees & woodland. Traffic would "rat run" through Rawdon village even more - cars are spoiling the village now. School traffic is already ridiculous.
