I would like to object to the three proposed housing sites in Bramhope i.e. HG2 – 15 Green Acres), HG2 – 16 (Creskeld Lane) and HG3 – 16 (Breary Lane East).

My principal reason for objecting is the extreme pressure the developments would have on an already overstretched and overused **highways and transport system**. In particular, the Creskeld Lane proposal for 23 houses would significantly increase traffic flow at the junction of Creskeld Lane and Breary Lane East which is well known as a hazardous junction. Also, the pressure on usage of the A660 would make this major route into town untenable.

All three developments would have a significant impact on the character of Bramhope, changing from a village to urban sprawl. Hence **conservation** of the (only recently established) conservation area is of major concern.

The loss of green belt would not only be disappointing, but would detrimentally effect residents' health as more congestion would lead to more pollution.

The **pressure on local services** if these developments went ahead would be onerous, hence making the proposals unviable.

For these reasons I object to the proposals and hope that the council decide likewise.
