Dear Sirs,

I am sending this email because of my concern over the amount of Green Belt land around Horsforth that has been earmarked for building, the proposal to include these Green Belt sites in the local plan is NOT consistent with the national policy. The proposal to use Green Belt land before Brownfield is not justified.

The proposal to use this Strategic Green Infrastructure goes against the Leeds Core Strategy.

This Green Belt Land is important not only to me and my family but also to the people of Horsforth they are what makes this area a good place to live, these areas help me and my family with wellbeing, health and exercise. I was born in Horsforth and have brought up my family here, it is the fact that Horsforth is surrounded, almost, by Green Belt Land that has kept me and my family in this area.

I have seen Horsforth become increasingly congested and it is not advisable to try and travel out of the area in the morning rush hour or between 3pm and 7pm simply because of the amount of traffic on the roads. I cannot imagine what it would be like with 1000 extra homes on the Ringroad. If this sort of development were to go ahead on the Green Belt it will change Horsforth for the worst and I, and my family, would seriously consider our future in the area.
