I am wanting to make my comments AGAINST the plans to put dwellings on the Church Lane Paddock site. My objections are as follows:

The increased volume of traffic to Church Lane, Green Road and Meanwood road junction. This has already increased since the Waitrose store has opened. The safety of children walking to the 2 local primary schools and one high school. There is a walking school bus in place and the increased traffic will put their safety at risk. Also the planning for dwellings on Meanwood working man's club, West Garth, Carr Manor and Meanwood Manner that's 102 plus the 25 on Church Paddock means another 127 houses in the area. An area that is already built up.

The 3 schools are already over subscribed. This will put extra pressure on school allocations.

There will also be extra pressure on doctors and dentist services in the area.

The loss of yet another much loved pasture/green site local area. The impact of the change in landscape of the church which is a grade 2 listed building.

If more housing is needed in Leeds, rather than building all new houses what about looking at regenerating some of the empty properties that are currently empty.
