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No! I want to formally and strongly object to the proposals to allow housing development on the Church Lane Paddock on the following ground:

- Destruction of important local heritage in that the green space is the only open space in Church Lane. The view of the Grade II listed church would be destroyed changing the character of the area irreparably.
- Traffic – Church Lane is already suffering from traffic caused by the development of the Waitrose supermarket. It is also used as a rat run by commuters travelling to and from the city centre. Any more housing development would add appreciably to this problem.
- Local amenities – Meanwood is already over populated from other housing development. Doctors, Dentist, schools and other services are stretched to the limit as recognised by the councils plans to increase school places. More housing would mean more people and exasperate this situation.
- Unsuitability of site – The site is very boggy and not suitable for development. It would also mean a loss of this type of habitat.
