Regarding the proposal to build 777 houses on this green belt land, I am writing to make the following objections.

1. The traffic in Horsforth is completely choked most of the time already.
2. There are insufficient school places for existing Horsforth children already without adding to the problem.
3. Green open space is imperative for the health and well-being of the residents and wildlife and is already being depleted rapidly.
4. My family does not want to live in an urban sprawl with no identity where all suburbs join together and become meaningless and insignificant.
5. It is already impossible to park in Horsforth, the streets around schools, the station, the University and shops are already dangerously lined with cars (many inconsiderately parked).

The infrastructure cannot cope already despite so-called improvements at the Ring Road/New Road Side roundabout, which have not helped at all. We live off West End Lane and we queue in traffic whenever we leave the house. I cannot imagine the misery a further 777 houses would bring on existing residents, not to mention people just trying to pass through the area.

I hope my comments will be taken into consideration when deciding the fate of this land.
