Initially I was shocked when my wife told me she'd heard there were plans to build on those fields. I thought there were rules against building in beautiful locations like this. It would make a continuous urbanisation from Rawdon through Yeadon to Guiseley ruining the character of the area.

We've lived in Yeadon Westfield Close for 6 years now and the traffic on the A65 has got worse each year we've been here. We now don't try to turn right from Westfield Avenue onto the A65 nr the Westfield chip shop as you can be stuck there for ages. We now have to drive down through Greenlea Rd and onto Warm Lane to avoid this junction as I think lots of drivers do. This is not good for anyone.

And also tonight and last thursday at 5 pm I drove up from the Horsforth Roundabout where the A65 crosses the ringroad only to see a continuous queue of traffic all the way up to the conservative club in Rawdon. That must be nearly 3 miles. Money well spent on that roundabout then! How will more houses help this situation.

And last night I tried to catch the no33 bus at 19.09 from Westfield to Leeds. The bus never arrived. My back up plan was to take the other no 33 bus 10 mins later in the direction of Guiseley to the station to catch the train into Leeds, and guess what, that didn't arrive either. The next bus would be 20.09. Thankfully it was only a social trip not work.

It makes no sense to build here as we just don't have working infrastructure to support it, it doesn't take much investigation to see that.
