I am writing to object to the proposed housing sites in Bramhope.

Site References and sites are:

HG2 – 16 (1002) Creskeld Lane, Bramhope –land to the rear of no. 45

HG2 – 17 (1080-3367A) Breary Lane East, Bramhope, LS16

This many houses will have a massive not to mention devastating effect on the local ecology, landscape and the Conservation area.

The A660 is the main route into and out of Leeds and it is already congested. There is no way this road can cope with the scale of the proposed development. The residents of Bramhope already struggled to deal with the current congestion getting into and out of the village.

Greenbelt land should be preserved at all costs and therefore this site should be left as a green belt site. We can't declare a site green belt in order to safe guard it from development only to say it doesn't matter when it suits.
