I wish to state that I do not agree with the proposed site to be developed for housing.

Besides the plan has not been properly reviewed by the residents, the idea of having anymore housing in Guiseley and the surrounding villages is completely unacceptable. We have already had our fair share of housing and we are quickly grinding to a halt. Guiseley Infants & Nursery and Guiseley St Oswalds school have both been expanded and turned into Primarys which has caused all sorts of problems with parking and just generally getting around. We really need a purpose built school to accommodate the children currently living here, never mind the extra ones which will naturally appear with more housing. The Leisure Centre is in a terrible state and looks like it needs knocking down. The football ground is far too small as the club seems to be doing really well and desperately needs it's own car park. The park is a complete disgrace for the size of Guiseley and we could probably do with at least another one, maybe on Tranmere park. We need more parking for the railway station as people are parking on both sides on A65 causing congestion and making it dangerous. The traffic lights at the station pub has made congestion even worse as the lights don't stay green long enough along A65 to keep the traffic moving. Another crossing has been put in from the Station pub across A65, which is so dangerous I'm surprised there hasn't been any serious accidents.

The traffic currently on Ings Lane is a nightmare with the residents having to park on the road side and parked cars from the football ground. It is virtually impossible to turn right at the end of the road onto A65 because of congestion but also because it is such a complicated junction. Guiseley and the surrounding villages are merging into a horrible mess and will soon be completely ruined. If I didn't have children in the local schools I would definitely be moving well away from this area, which is a shame as I am Guiseley born and bread.

I hope that you will take some notice of what the locals are saying and just try to make the area better, not worse.
