### TO WHOM IT CONCERNS

Primarily as a Leeds citizen I'm very concerned for our future generations that our precious Greenbelts are protected and not hastily designated for unnecessary housing sites.

I feel strongly that the following allocated sites should NOT be included in plans for development as they are not consistent with National Policy:

- 1) HG2- 12 Fields at Woodlands Drive, Rawdon
- 2) HG3- 2, HG3 -3, HG3-4 the fields off A65, Rawdon
- 3) HG2-41 Fields south of the A65, Horsforth Roundabout to Rawdon Crematorium
- 4) HG2-43 – Fields at Horsforth College Campus.

The use of Brownfield areas before planning on Green Belt is NOT justified and goes against Leeds Core Strategy.

It is recognised that intensive house building in restricted areas is not conducive to healthy living and therefore would create more problems for Leeds citizens in the future.

Personally I do not want my family in future to live with the knowledge that Leeds Core Strategy was not adhered to and that they will have to live with the consequences of those ill-thought decisions.

I am proud of the fact that I've returned to my father's family roots and can now enjoy the benefits of a vibrant and green city. I want that pride to be held by my children and their children in the years to come.
