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I want to object to the proposed housing sites in Bramhope.

HG2 – 16 (1002) Creskeld Lane, Bramhope –land to the rear of no. 45

HG2 – 17 (1080-3367A) Breary Lane East, Bramhope, LS16

The A660 is the main route into and out of Leeds and it is already totally congested.
