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We cannot understand why Leeds wishes to allocate more sites for housing than Government statistics suggest thus infringing substantially on the Green Belt.

This allocation would disproportionately increase the size of the village and, additionally, being on the periphery is likely to produce a sub village with its only connection to Bramhope being its postal address. Leeds does not need more of the types of housing developers will want to build here but rather many more affordable homes.

There is a lack of demographic evidence to support this proposal which would lead to unacceptable loss of green belt with an adverse effect on the environment and ecology.

The local infrastructure is inadequate to support this increase.

Neither the A660 corridor nor the public transport system cannot cope with the extra traffic which would ensue.

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
