Dear Sir/Madam,

I write in response to the proposal to consider building on green belt land within the Horsforth and Rawdon areas of Leeds. The sites I am particularly concerned about are :-

HG2-41 Fields south of A65, Horsforth roundabout to the crematorium

HG2-43 Fields at Horsforth College Campus

HG2-12 Fields at Woodlands Drive, Rawdon

HG3-2, HG3-3, HG3-4 Fields off A65, Rawdon

Having lived in Horsforth at my present address for over 30 years I have experienced many difficulties caused by the increase in traffic in the area. The development of the old Sandoz site (brown field) between Horsforth and Rodley to provide more housing has only made the problems with traffic increase. As more houses on that site continue to be built it will only get worse.

The proposal to build on the above listed green belt sites will result in yet further difficulties with traffic movement, probably resulting in major delays due to gridlock at peak times. The additional frustration and stress caused by this will not be helped by the lack of green space to enjoy.

Having walked through and enjoyed the above green belt sites regularly during the past 30 years (with my children, and latterly grandchildren) I feel that it is important to maintain these areas for the well-being of Horsforth residents. I would urge the relevant authority to ensure that this green belt remains just that – green belt.
