It is with great distress that I read that you are, yet again, thinking of building on the green belt in this area. In particular sites HG2-12 Fields at Woodlands Drive, Rawdon, HG3-2 HG3-4 Fields off the A65, Rawdon, HG2-41 fields off A65, Rawdon and HG2-43 Fields at Horsforth College Campus.

Anyone that thinks there is no problem with the traffic on the A65 needs their head examining. I moved into my house on the A65 some 35 years ago and have watched the traffic grow and grow and the green belt go and go. I am elderly now and have become scared to set foot near the main road which is no longer safe due to the volume of traffic on the A65 and Apperley Lane/ We have already got houses being built on Green Lane and I hate to think how much more traffic you are proposing to put here, how much strain on already overcrowded schools and doctors' practices, Already the cars from the EMIS workers are parked all the way up the main road and even on our estate, how much more do we have to put up with.

The proposal to include these Green Belt sites is not consistent with the national policy and the proposal to use Green Belt before brownfield is not justified. The proposal to use this Strategic Green Infrastructure goes against the Leeds Core Strategy.

When I moved into this house it was a nice quiet estate once the rush hour traffic had gone and my children had plenty of green spaces to look at and play in and walk in.
Now I cannot wait to get away from it, but the way I am feeling now I will probably be moved to Rawdon Crematorium!!
