Dear Sirs

With reference to your proposed building developments on green belt land in Rawdon / Horsforth we strongly object to this.

The development is not justified.

The A65 is full and over capacity.

At the moment the roads through Rawdon to Horsforth are gridlocked. Traffic is using Rawdon Town Street down to Horsforth as the A65 is constantly gridlocked. You have spent god knows how much money on the development of the roundabouts with lights at Horsforth and Rodley and now it is twice as bad on and around the ring road at Horsforth. Action really needs to be taken to sort this out.

Also building on green belt sites should not be considered when there are plenty of brown sites which have been earmarked for development and which could be developed.
